Fees will be waived when a custodian is on duty for school-related events, such as extracurricular activities, school fundraisers, and parent information meetings, if net proceeds are directed to the District or a District-affiliated organization (parent/teacher clubs, student body groups, etc.) to support students. Custodial service fees may apply outside of business hours.		This category includes youth organizations that benefit MUSD students and city-run recreational programs from Manteca, Lathrop, and Stockton. To be eligible for this discounted fee class, the group/Facility User must provide a roster proving 80% of participants are MUSD students <u>and</u> must show proof of active nonprofit status <u>or</u> documentation that participants are charged no more than \$60 per month. Permit processing fees, utility fees, discounted direct cost fees, and custodial service fees may apply.			This category includes all other Facility Users not explicitly identified in Class 1 - 4 and not in conflict with Board Policy. This includes Facility Users whose activities are for-profit, and Facility Users who are not district residents or community groups. Permit processing fees, utility fees, fair rental value fees, and custodial service fees apply.

This category includes civic groups, public agencies, and service-based youth organizations that host informational/public interest meetings or conduct community service events with no admission fees. This category also includes high school extended-season sports teams, as approved by the school's Athletic Director, whose rosters consist of at least 90% MUSD student athletes who play for the internal high school team. Permit processing fees, utility fees, and custodial service fees may apply.		This category includes religious organizations and district resident/community groups with active nonprofit status, including youth organizations who do not meet the requirements of Class 3. Permit processing fees, utility fees, direct cost fees, and custodial service fees apply.			Per Education Code 38134 (e), in the case of entertainment or a meeting where an admission fee is charged or contributions are solicited, and the net receipts are not expended for the welfare of the pupils of the school district or for charitable purposes, any group, regardless of classification within this fee schedule, will be subject to a charge equal to fair rental value for the use of the school facilities or grounds.
