State College Area School District Community Education offers full and half day camps for youth in Grades 1-5 (Fall 2026). Students will choose two educational short-term enrichment classes for morning activities* and are divided into age-appropriate groups for afternoon activities that include recreational games and crafts.

**Students will register for classes later in the spring. Class details are still being developed and will be posted at our summer camp website as soon as possible.*

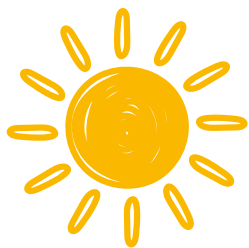
Weekly from June 15 to July 31 (no camp week of June 29)

Times

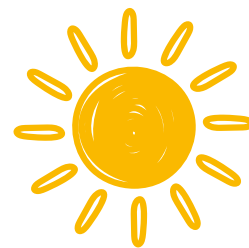
Half Day	9:15 a.m. - 12:15 p.m. (Choose two educational “shorts” classes*)
Full Day	9:15 a.m. - 5:00 p.m. (Includes two educational “shorts” classes* in the morning and recreational activities in the afternoon)
Extended Morning	Add on to your registration to allow drop off between 8:00 a.m. to 9:15 a.m.

Half Day: \$190 per week

Full Day: \$285 per week

Extended Morning: \$22 per week

OPTIONAL Friday Pizza Lunch: \$8.25 per week

Notes

- Families must provide their own transportation to and from camp.
- Students must bring a lunch, two snacks and drinks (all products must be nut-free).
- Friday Pizza Lunch includes two slices of cheese pizza, a juice box or bottle of water, applesauce or fruit cup, and a snack (ie-Goldfish, Scooby Snack).
- There is limited enrollment in each week/course; registrations are accepted on a first-come, first-served basis.
- Students will be grouped by age/grade for afternoon activities.
- Course offerings are subject to change.

Morning “Shorts” Classes

At this time, you will merely be registering for specific weeks of Shorts & Sports. Class registration will take place at a later date. Each morning consists of two 60-minute classes, which run from 9:20 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. each day. We are excited to partner with a variety of youth program providers, as well as SCASD teachers, to offer STEM, art, and physical activity classes this summer. More information regarding specific offerings will be available later in the spring, so please keep an eye on your email for more details!

Payment and Wavier Details

AT THE TIME OF REGISTRATION, YOU WILL BE ASKED TO REVIEW AND AGREE TO THE FOLLOWING WAIVER. PLEASE READ IT CAREFULLY PRIOR TO REGISTERING.

- The District's Health & Safety Plan will be followed.
- You must complete a cancellation/change of schedule form for all cancellations or change requests. You can find this form on the summer camp web page.
- No refunds are granted for cancellations made with less than ten BUSINESS days' notification prior to the start of a program.
- All cancellations are subject to a \$20 cancellation fee per student, per camp. If you cancel and you have paid in full, you may be charged a fee for the refund. We pass along any charge we incur from our processor.
- There will be no reduction in fees if your child does not attend the program for any reason (ie - due to illness, behavior, weather-related cancellations, etc).
- You are responsible for keeping an updated card on file for the payment plan and any additional fees you may incur. If your payment fails, you will receive a system automated email notification. You must log in to your account, update your card and process the appropriate payment amount. Accounts with a balance due five (5) days after the payment due date will be assessed a late fee of \$25. Should your balance due remain unpaid three (3) business days after this fee is assessed, your child's future camp enrollments will be cancelled and you will receive no refund.
- You should receive a confirmation email upon successful registration. You can always check your current registrations by logging in to your registration account and clicking My Activities in the left panel. This will show all active registrations.

Payment

Payment may be made with a Visa or MasterCard. There is a non-refundable \$25 registration fee per student. If you register before the end of April, you will have the option of putting your invoice on a payment plan. Registrations that take place on May 1st or later are required to be paid in full at the time of registration.

Payment Plans

Payment plans carry a one-time fee of \$15, paid at the time of registration. If you would like to utilize the payment plan option, on the Payment page, select the Payment Plan button located in the Select a Payment Option box. Click the button and your invoice will be divided into two monthly payments, May 4 and June 1, 2026. Specific dates and payment amounts can be viewed by clicking the Details drop down next to the payment plan button. You will pay only a 3% deposit today plus the payment plan fee. If you fail to put the invoice on a payment plan, you will pay the entire invoice. Should you inadvertently do this and require a refund, you will be charged a fee equal to 5% of the refunded amount, not to exceed \$100. Additionally, should you ever inadvertently pay more than you intend and require a refund, you will be charged this fee. Please read everything carefully prior to checking out and contact our office if you have any questions.

Students with Special Needs

If your child has an IEP or 504 plan, has a chronic health condition or exceptional needs, please contact our office to ensure that your child's needs are met while at camp. Your child's Special Education team may make additional recommendations based on your child's needs.
