8TH GRADE COURSE SELECTION

WHAT WILL IT LOOK LIKE FOR AN 8TH GRADER?

6 Classes Daily

- English 8 – yearlong
- US History 2 – yearlong (this meets Washington State History graduation requirement)
- Math - yearlong
- Science – yearlong
- PE for (1) Semester

Room for 3 semester length Elective Classes or 1 Full Year Elective class + 1 semester length Elective

- Band, Orchestra, Choir, Spanish, and French would be one Full Year elective

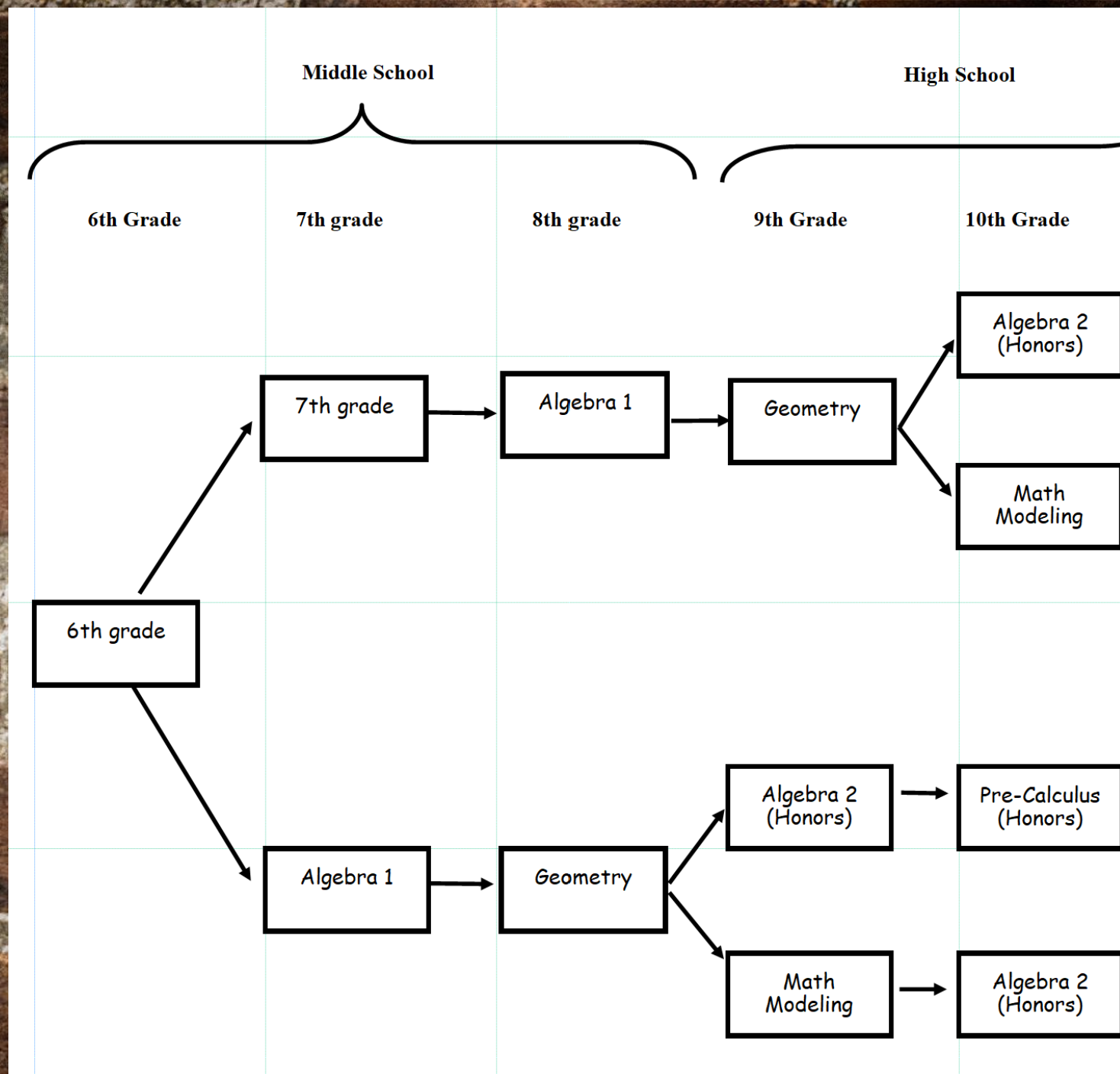

HIGH SCHOOL COURSES TAKEN IN MIDDLE SCHOOL FOR CREDIT

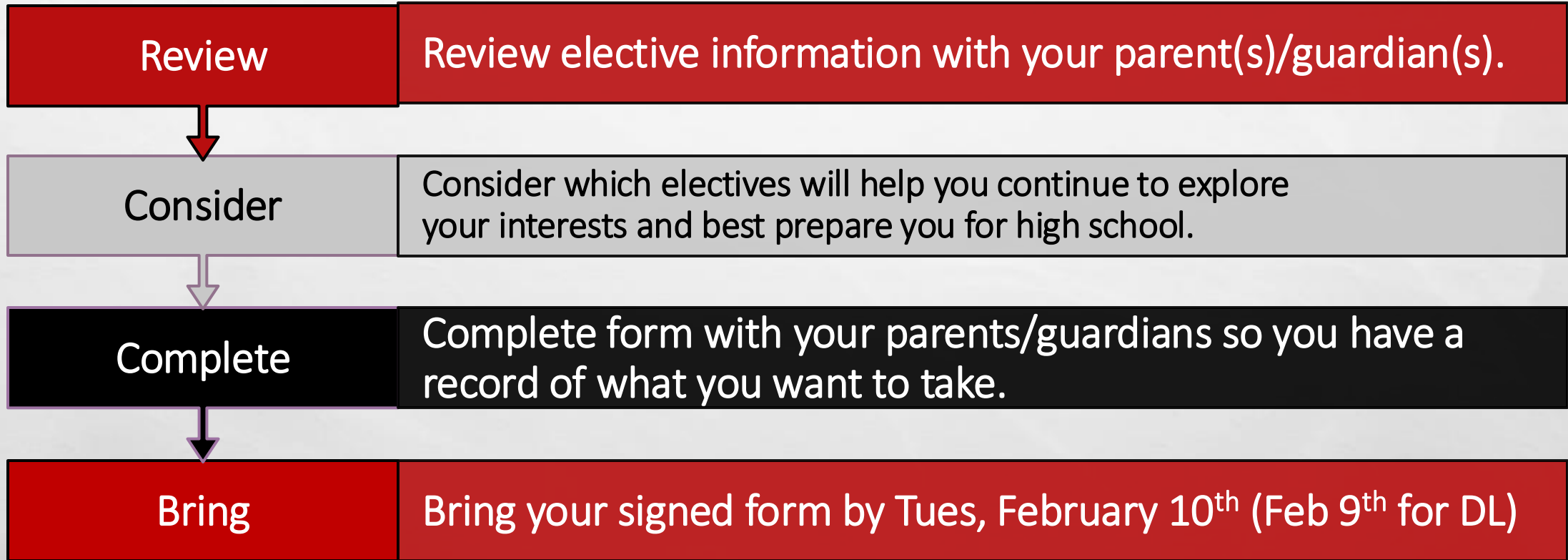
