I should have taken two Running Start classes in order to get 6 free college credits at FVCC.

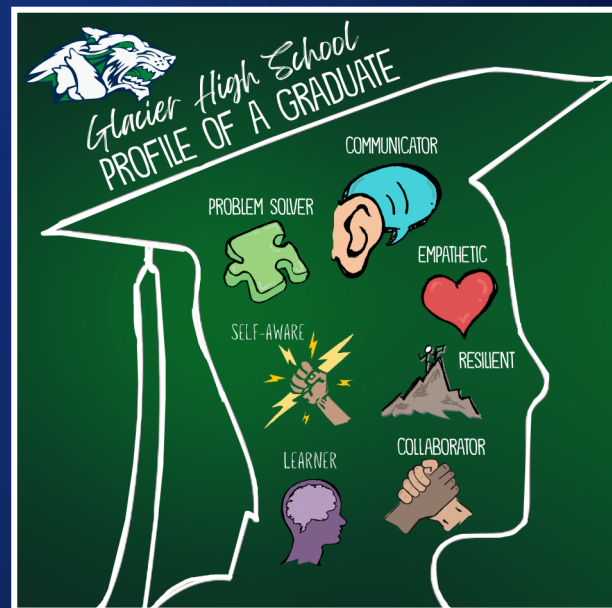
I wish I would have taken an engineering class my freshman year so I could get all four years in my schedule.
