1. Narrative description of the Prop 28 arts education program(s) funded. (2500 character limit).

The funds will support the following: 1. Developing a New Art Program with Future Expansion into an AP Art Program: One of the key initiatives will be the creation of a new art program that offers foundational courses in visual arts, such as drawing and painting. As the program grows, it will expand to include more advanced coursework, including the development of an Advanced Placement (AP) Art program. 2. Hiring a New Teacher: To support the growth of the art program, the funds will be used to hire a qualified art teacher. This teacher will not only teach existing classes but will also play a pivotal role in designing and implementing the new curriculum, fostering a creative learning environment, and helping students develop their artistic skills. 3. Purchasing Classroom Furniture and Art-Specific Items: In order to create a functional and inspiring space for students to explore their creativity, Prop 28 funds will be used to purchase classroom furniture such as easels, drawing tables, and storage units for art supplies. Additionally, art-specific items such as sinks for painting and display areas for finished work will be added to the classroom. These investments in physical infrastructure will create an environment that enhances the learning experience. 4. Materials, Both Consumables and Non-Consumables: The funds will also be allocated to purchasing a wide range of materials necessary for the program. Consumable materials such as paints, brushes, canvases, clay, and sketchbooks will be provided to students to ensure they have the resources they need for their projects. Non-consumable materials, such as cameras, lighting equipment, or software for digital art, may also be acquired, supporting students in exploring new media and expanding their creative abilities.
