Write Your Own Will

Having a will is important for married couples, singles and divorced people. If you are without a will, the laws of Minnesota and a judge will make all the decisions regarding your estate. Don't let this happen. Learn about estates and wills, and prepare a legal will in class. Receive instructions and a professionally prepared form, have access to witnesses and a notary public. Prior to class, review the information forwarded to you. The will form is designed for individual use; couples cannot share this form (each person must register individually). Appropriate for people who have an estate of less than \$2,000,000, including life insurance, and do not own a business. Must bring your driver's license for identification. Tuition Assistance

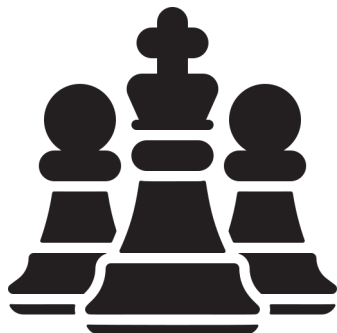

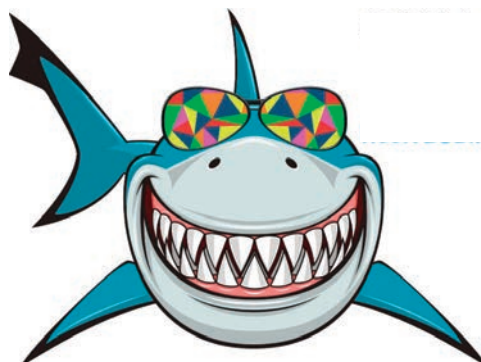

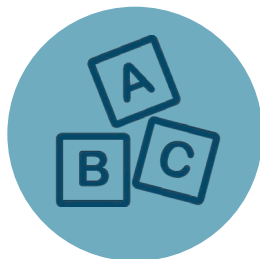
Early Childhood Family Education (ECFE)

- ECFE stands for Early Childhood Family Education.
- Unique to Minnesota, ECFE classes provide opportunities for children and parents to learn and grow together. The program strengthens families through play, education and support. Parent education can be provided individually or separate from children or together as a family.
- It is based on the idea that parents provide their child's first and most significant learning environment and parents are children's first and most enduring teachers.
- Licensed parent educators and early childhood teachers team to make each class a welcoming, rich experience for both parents and children.
- ECFE classes are offered from birth to 5 years, with many options to fit your schedule, including evenings and Saturdays.



Parent Education

- Parent Education is embedded in all ECFE Classes to provide support and encouragement in your role as a parent or caregiver.
- Current research-based information on child development is standard.
- Peer connection: We are in this together!
- Community Connections: Awareness of community resources and support services.
- Classes denoted with this symbol have a separate parent discussion time or are a parent only class.



Preschool Classes

- Learning is a social process where children grow through play and exploration. Preschool programs focus on creating a strong foundation for learning.

Sibling Care/Sibcare Policy

Sibling care gives parents the opportunity to spend individualized time with their child in an age specific class and to fully engage during parent discussion time. If a family is taking an age specific class (examples-infants, toddlers, 2s and 3s, etc) children who are not in the age group should register for sibling care. Our sibcare room is staffed by a qualified teacher who leads age appropriate exploration, activities and play. This service is available for siblings 4 months through age 5 as part of our ECFE program. Babies under 4 months may attend any class with their family. Classes that include sibcare, are designated in the description. Register at the same time you register for your ECFE class.

Online - Classes will be taught as interactive webinars which are accessible on most computers, phones and tablets. You will be emailed a link to the class with further instructions, 1-3 days before the start of the class. Please provide a valid email address during registration.

Off-site - Class location information is located in the catalog under the class section. You may also find location information in the course confirmation emailed to you at the time of registration and also in the course reminder emailed two days before the class start date.
