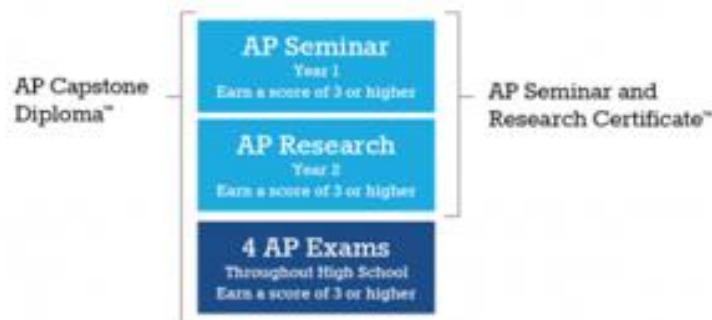

**Stanford Summer Data Science & AI Program (Online) – Opportunity for Your Students**



High school students (grades 9–12) are invited to apply to **Stanford Medicine's Stanford Data Ocean Online Summer Camp**, a 4-week online program focused on **data science, AI/ML, and precision medicine**.

Students will work with real biomedical datasets, learn foundational data science and AI/ML skills, and earn two **Stanford Genetics** certificates upon completion:

- Fundamentals of Data Science in Precision Medicine and Cloud Computing
- Fundamentals of AI/ML in Precision Medicine

The camp includes self-paced modules, live instructor sessions, weekly office hours, access to an AI tutor, and a collaborative team capstone project. **No coding experience is required.**

- **Application fee:** \$0
- **Program fee after acceptance:** \$1,500
- **Need-based scholarships are available, and we encourage students requiring financial assistance to apply.**
