The Central Wisconsin State Fair Board (CWSF) and Junior Fair Board are pleased to offer a \$1,000 and a \$500 scholarship to individuals planning to enroll in or currently attending a post-secondary institution. This scholarship can be used to cover expenses at either a technical college or a university. The CWSF and Junior Fair scholarship committee will select the recipient.

Scholarship Guidelines:

1. Applicants must be high school seniors.
2. Applicants must provide documentation verifying their enrollment in a post-secondary institution.
3. Applicants must have participated with the CWSF.
4. Applicants must submit this scholarship application along with 2 letters of recommendation (one from a community person and one from your 4-H Club, FFA, or other youth organization leader).
5. The application form must be typed, and all questions answered.
6. The winner will be announced at the Central Wisconsin State Fair Junior Fair awards program on Thursday of the fair.
