- ❖ Tuition includes most School-related costs, such as:
  - Lunch and snacks
  - Books, art supplies, and musical instruments
  - Montgomery School team sports and performing arts events
  - Use of School-owned Technology, except as provided below
  - Most same-day field trips
  
- ❖ Tuition does not include the following costs, which will be charged as additional incidental fees:
  - Tuition Refund Plan fees (mandatory for 2- and 10-payment plans)
  - Lost or damaged technology equipment (e.g., Chromebook screens, keyboards, and chargers)
  - Middle School overnight trips
  - Unreturned library books or school equipment
  - Before- and after-school activities, and programs on non-school days
  
- ❖ What does Tuition primarily cover?
  - While tuition is essential to the financial health of Montgomery School, it does not fully cover the true cost of educating each child. Like most independent schools, we rely on both tuition and philanthropic support to sustain our programs, care for our campus, and invest in the people who make our school exceptional. Annual tuition increases help address rising operating costs, most significantly, the cost of providing competitive salaries and benefits for our dedicated faculty and staff.
