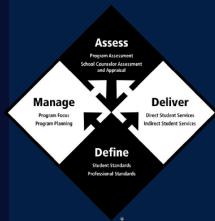

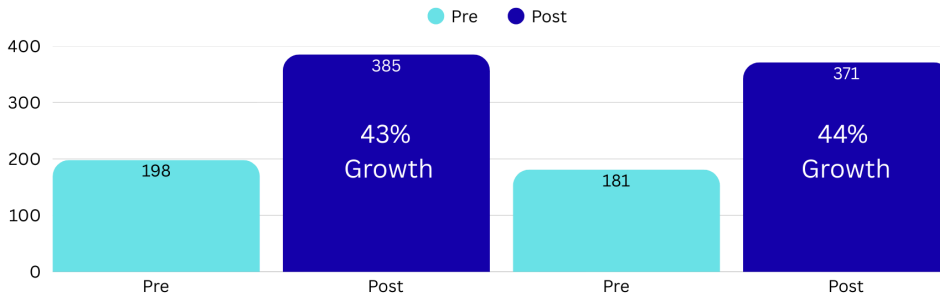

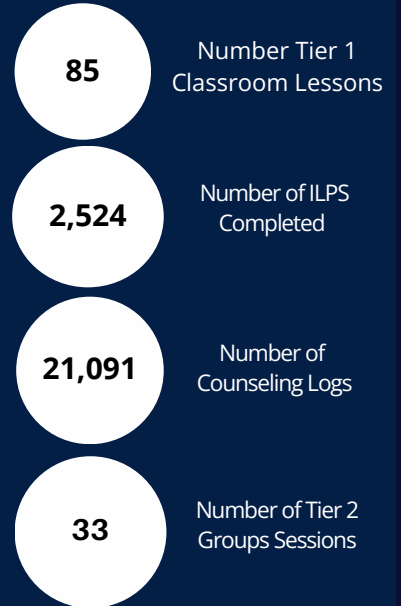

ANNUAL STUDENT OUTCOME GOAL



For the 2025-26 school year, the counseling department has two goals:

- By June 2026, 12th-grade students at Redwood High School will increase the number of students graduating A-G prepared by 6%, from 325 students to 360 students.
- By June 2026, students in grades 9–12 at Redwood High School will increase participation in dual enrollment and concurrent college courses by 50%, from 189 students to 284 students.
