


Accessing Teams on a Laptop Computer

You can use the Microsoft Teams app on the computer (recommended) or you can access Microsoft Teams online.


Using the Microsoft Teams app on your computer

1. Microsoft Teams should open automatically when you turn on your computer. If it doesn't, open up, do this:


Go to the **search bar** in the bottom of your computer screen and type **Microsoft Teams**. Click on the Microsoft Teams icon when it appears.



*You may have to log in with your username and password. This information is on your login sheet beside **Microsoft 365**.



2. The class team name that you are in will appear on the left side. If it is not the right class, click on **All teams** and choose the correct class team.




Using Microsoft Teams Online

1. Double-click the **white 1:1 student tools icon** on your screen.
2. Click on **Microsoft 365**.




3. It should log you in automatically, but if not, login with the username and password beside **Microsoft 365** on your login sheet.




4. If you don't see the Teams app on the left side, click on **Apps**. Then click on **Teams**. You may have to click on **All apps** to find the Teams app.




5. When you're in your class team, you will see a **blue bar and camera icon** that shows that your teacher has started a meeting. Click **Join**. *You may need to click on **All teams** to get in the correct class team.



6. You will come to a screen where you can turn on your camera and microphone so your teacher can see and hear you. Turn them on and click **Join Now**.



7. During the meeting, your screen will look similar to the picture below.

Students will use Microsoft Teams to engage in activities during Remote Learning Days. They will click on this icon  in the taskbar at the bottom of their screen. If it is not in the taskbar, type “Teams” in the search bar and select the application from here.




