## Amendment to the FSMC Contract RFP NO: 20-0003 beginning July 1, 2020

This extension amendment, effective January 1, 2026, is made by and between HENDRY COUNTY SCHOOL DISTRICT, FLORIDA ("SFA"), and SODEXO AMERICA, LLC ("FSMC").

This extension amendment ("Extension"), upon execution by both Parties and attached to the Original Contract, shall serve as an agreement to extend the term of the Fourth Renewal Amendment of the Original Contract RFP NO: 20-0003 for SIX (6) MONTHS in accordance with the terms of the Original Contract and any written amendments signed by the Parties as well as the terms provided herein.

The contract shall be amended to:

- The Parties agree to extend the Fourth Renewal Amendment of the Original Contract for an additional SIX (6)-MONTH period, which will begin immediately upon the expiration of the Original Contract period extension currently in place and will end on 6/30/2026.
- This Extension binds and benefits both Parties. This document, including the attached Original Contract, as amended, is the entire agreement between the Parties.
- The terms and conditions in the contract shall remain unchanged and in full force and effect, including the rates from the Fourth Renewal Amendment effective July 1, 2024. Such fixed price shall be adjusted effective January 1, 2026, once the new contract is executed by both Parties.


