BUDGET MTG Purpose: The Budget Advisory Committee is an advisory body to the Buckeye Union School District Governing Board. The Committee provides a valuable resource to the Superintendent and his designees by enhancing communication, providing opportunities for input on the budgetary process, and obtaining support for decisions ultimately made by the District's Governing Board. LCAP MTG Purpose: Each District and Charter School in the State of California is required to develop and annually update the Local Control and Accountability Plan (LCAP) following a process of community engagement, needs assessment, goal setting, and progress monitoring. The resources supporting the plan come from the State of California and its Local Control Funding Formula for public schools that accounts for approximately 88% of the District's annual funding.

Each District and Charter School is required to convene an LCAP Parent Advisory Committee, annually, in order to provide an opportunity for parents to participate with District administrators, teachers, and support staff in the development and evaluation of the LCAP. [LCAP Document Links](#)
