PROFICIENCY-BASED GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS (PBGRs)

It is the policy of the Barre Unified Union School District (BUUSD) to ensure students can engage in rigorous, relevant and comprehensive learning opportunities that allow them to demonstrate proficiency in literacy, mathematics, scientific inquiry, global citizenship, physical education, artistic expression, and transferable skills. A student meets the requirements for graduation when the student demonstrates evidence of proficiency in these curriculum content areas, and when they meet any additional graduation requirements described by this Board.

The BUUSD will use credits for the purpose of demonstrating that a student has met the high school graduation requirements. Credits will specify the proficiencies demonstrated in order to attain a credit and shall not be based on time spent in learning. Students in the BUUSD will receive credit for learning that takes places outside of the school, school day, or the classroom, provided that any credits earned occur under the supervision of an appropriately licensed educator.
