The Brian Breen Scholarship at Fairview High School (FHS) was established in 2022 in memory of Brian Breen, an accomplished FHS alumnus who very sadly lost his battle with ALS in 2020. A 1978 graduate of FHS, Brian excelled both academically and athletically at FHS, playing multiple sports including basketball, football, golf and tennis. He lettered in both tennis and golf and was the captain of the golf team in his senior year. Brian went on to obtain a BA in accounting from Marietta College, an MBA from Brenau University, had a very successful career in business and finance, and enjoyed a blessed life.

To honor Brian's spirit of commitment, integrity, and passion for all sports but especially golf, this scholarship was created by his family and friends to provide support for an FHS Senior athlete whose achievements, character, contributions and potential exemplify those manifested in Brian's life.

- Minimum GPA of 2.5
