Moving to Asynchronous Remote Learning Snow Days

The district has used all three traditional snow days that were included in the approved calendar!



The next snow day will be a remote learning day, students will stay home and are expected to complete academic assignments asynchronously. Remote learning days will not need to be added to the calendar at the end of the year. There is a [dedicated page](#) on our school website that more fully describes weather-related closures. Additionally, each school has sent out specific information about the expectations and procedures for those days.

Food Service Plans for Remote Learning Days -

Meals will be provided during remote learning snow days. Non-perishable meals have already been sent home in advance with all students for whom a meal has been requested. [Please fill out this form](#) to have your child's name added to the list of kids receiving a meal or communicate with us if you believe you signed up previously and have not seen that food sent home with your child.

If you have multiple children, please fill out the form for each child individually. After each remote learning snow day, we will send home another non-perishable meal for possible future remote learning days. You do not need to resubmit on the form again for each remote learning snow day. Once you are on the list you are on it for the winter, if you would like to be removed from the list, please contact your school.

We are delighted to welcome our newest students to Scarborough Public Schools for Kindergarten in the 2026-2027 school year!

Eligibility Requirements

Kindergarten is open to any student who meets the following age criteria:

- The child must turn five (5) years old on or before October 15, 2026.

Registration Instructions

If your child meets the eligibility criteria, please follow the instructions below to ensure they are accounted for in our planning:

- **Complete the Enrollment Form:** All prospective students must complete the [New Student Enrollment Form](#)
- **Action for Undecided Parents:** If your child meets the age requirement, but you are currently undecided about sending them to school due to their age or developmental level, we still request that you complete the [REGISTRATION FORM](#) now. This is crucial for us to accurately plan for all potential students for the upcoming year.

Next Steps and Important Information

- **Paperwork Review/Student Screening:** Appointments will be scheduled later this spring at each of our schools to review necessary paperwork, including the notarization of residency and a brief screening for the students. More information will be provided throughout the spring.
- **Health Concerns:** If your child has specific health concerns, you are encouraged to call or set up an appointment with one of our school nurses at any time.
- **Assistance and Interpretation:** We are happy to meet with you and provide an interpreter if you would like help completing these forms. Please call any of the school offices listed below


Backpack Program


