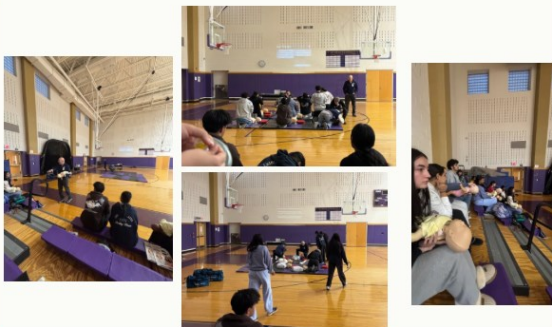

EntreX Lab is a dual-enrollment Entrepreneurship class taught in partnership with the University of Delaware.

## \$5 Challenge Winning Team Raised \$630 for Charity

EntreX Lab students competed in the \$5 Challenge, a class competition designed to foster creativity and problem-solving skills. Student teams were given \$5 credit and a week to earn as much money as possible using this small start-up capital and their current resources.
