SCHOLARSHIP TIPS

When writing a scholarship essay or listing your activities, be sure to make your memberships quantifiable. For example, instead of stating you are a member of the Sandy Creek Marching Band, add some specifics. Try "As the section leader of percussion section, I helped lead the percussion section to two first place percussion ensemble during our 2025 competition season". Judges review lots of applications, so it is important to show them what sets you apart from other applicants.



CHECK YOUR SOCIAL MEDIA PRESENCE

Did you know that some scholarships ask for your social media handles? In other words, they review their finalists' social media presence. What does your social media say about you? Try Googling yourself to see what comes up first. Be sure your accounts are private. Take time to review past posts to ensure they represent you in a good way. Remember, your social media is a part of your brand. Always present yourself in a good and positive manner.
