Review your Teacher Recommendations for the 2026-2027 school year within your Academic Planner in Infinite Campus

3

Review the "Next Year Considerations" tab in Infinite Campus if you're considering enrolling in an Advanced Placement (AP) course for the upcoming year

4

Select Elective and Alternate Courses in the Academic Planner on Infinite Campus

5

Ensure that you have (7) Courses and (3) Alternate courses listed in your Academic Planner by 4:00 PM on February 6



ADVANCED PLACEMENT (AP)

Check the “Next Year Considerations” tab in the Infinite Campus Academic Planner to see which AP Classes you meet the prerequisites

Please Note: AP Recommendations / Requests will be put in academic planner initially by teachers for core courses and by the student when selecting electives

AP Contracts are due on **March 19, 2026**; they will be included on the course request document that the parent and student must sign and return to SMHS

Students must submit requests to drop AP courses before the county deadline of **June 1, 2026**

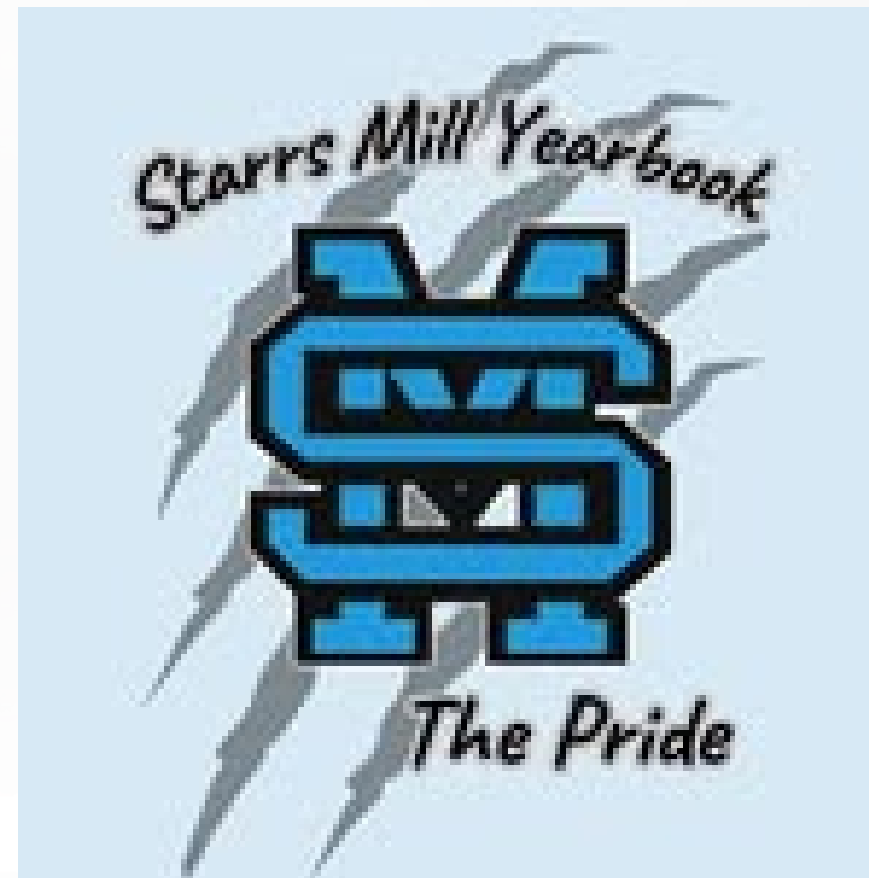

HOW TO REQUEST COURSES IN THE ACADEMIC PLANNER IN INFINITE CAMPUS

1 Log into Infinite Campus



2 Under the Student menu, go to Academic Planner

3 To review Course Catalog information and save available items to the plan, type any part of the course number or title in the *Search the Course Catalog* drop-down menu

4 Click on the desired course for more details

5 If available, buttons will display to add the course to the plan in a particular grade level.

- If these options are visible but grayed out, a prerequisite must be selected prior to selecting upper level courses

6 To add courses directly in the plan, locate the applicable Credit Area and click in the Grade Level to add

7 Click on the desired course to add

8 Click Save to add selections

9 A pop-up message with warnings/errors will appear for incomplete plans

10 Click OK to proceed

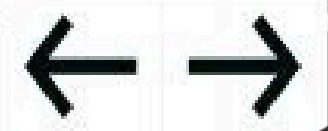

UNDERSTANDING YOUR GRADE POINT AVERAGE (GPA)

- All student GPAs are reported as weighted GPA
- **WEIGHTED:** Includes additional quality points for Advanced Placement (AP) and Dual Enrollment (DE) courses
- Advanced Placement (AP) courses receive 1 additional quality point
- Dual Enrollment (DE) courses receive 0.5 additional quality point
- To be an HONOR GRADUATE, the student's Weighted Cumulative GPA must be 3.5 or above at the end of fall semester of your senior year
