# Acceleration Point Classes

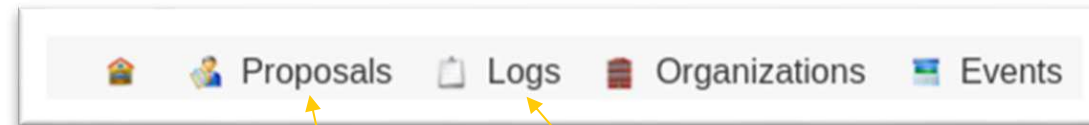
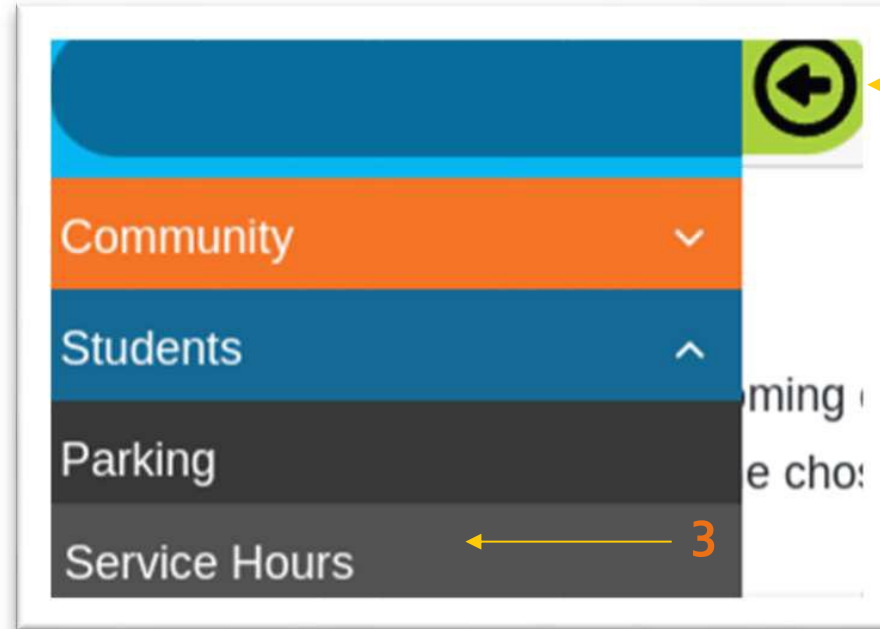
