Please allow adequate time to connect to internet and Microsoft Teams Meeting prior to **10:00 AM**. Subcontractors are also encouraged to attend.

The bidders assume the risk of any delay in the receipt of the bids. The bidder assumes all responsibility for having their bid is delivered by the time specified. The bids will be opened and read aloud by MPS District staff on a Microsoft Teams Meeting on **Wednesday, April 8, 2026 10:30 AM**.
