- Connecting families to school and community resources
- Ensuring students have access to supplies, meals, and academic support
- Offering compassion, confidentiality, and advocacy

Every situation is different, and support is tailored to each student’s needs.

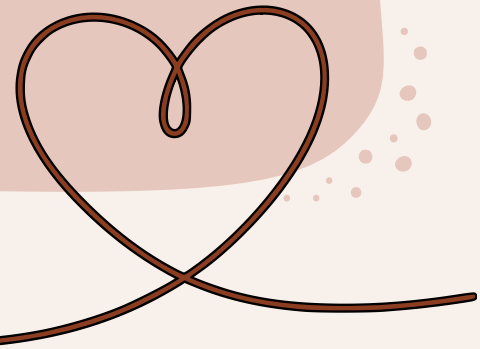
Our Message to Families
