Monarch High School offers multiple college-level academic opportunities that help students experience rigorous course content and the opportunity to earn college credit at low or no cost.

Advanced Placement (AP) Monarch offers an impressive 20 AP courses; more than most high schools in the country. AP courses give Monarch students a way to experience college-level academics and earn cost-effective college credits that are accepted at most four-year colleges in the United States and colleges in more than 60 other countries. Students may enroll in as many or as few AP courses as they wish. With hundreds of students in AP classes, pass rates far above state and national averages, 138 AP Scholars, and 2 National AP Scholars in 2019, Monarch students take every advantage of these opportunities.

CU Succeed (CU) At a very reasonable cost, *CU Succeed* offers students access to University of Colorado (CU) classes that are taught on the Monarch campus by CU-accredited Monarch faculty. Grades and credits appear on both Monarch and CU transcripts and are accepted at most colleges and universities across the country. Monarch offers more CU Succeed classes than virtually any other school in the state.

Concurrent Enrollment (CE) As a satellite campus of Front Range Community College (FRCC), Monarch offers students the opportunity to earn college credits on Monarch campus during the school year. The associated cost of these courses is covered by BVSD.

More options Monarch students can also qualify to attend college classes on the college campus as part of their high school curriculum.
