## Counselor's Corner

### 8th Grade Families! Promotion Information

The school year is well underway and now is a good time to review the requirements for 8th grade promotion and related activities. They are:

#### Promotion Requirements

1. Achieve a cumulative 2.0 GPA (average of whole year, not just 4th quarter)
2. No "F" grades in the 4th quarter
3. No more than 3 days of suspension in the 4th quarter.

Mrs. Gillig, our counselor, will be meeting with each 8th grader through the month of November and December to review these requirements and their individual progress toward promotion.

Please encourage your 8th grade student to complete classwork on time, make up assignments as needed and to talk with their teachers if they have questions. Missing assignments and incomplete work can negatively affect a students' overall grade and progress toward promotion..

Reminder! We have support on campus for our 7-8th graders to take advantage of including after school tutoring Tuesday-Thursday 2:30-3:30.





### Updated Cell Phone Policy for 2025-26 School Year

We would like to follow up on recently announced changes to our cell phone policy for the 2025-26 school year. As stated in a letter sent home to parents and guardians, students will not be able to use their cell phones during instructional time. Students will be required to place their phones in an identified space in their classrooms, and their phones will need to be turned off.

We want to reiterate that students will place their own cell phones in an assigned area inside their classroom at the start of each class period or school day, and personally retrieve them when their class period or school day is over. At our high school campuses, students will have access to their phones during passing periods and at lunch.

In the case of an emergency at school, it is common to want to reach your student or have them contact you with updates. However, we want to prevent the spread of false or incomplete information during a crisis situation, and first responders and law enforcement recommend that we do whatever we can to keep this
