Note: This outline is based on completing the Voice program within a one-year timeframe; however, a fifth term is available if additional time is needed due to the scheduling of state and/or national exams. It does not account for the transfer of prior coursework or for classes that may be challenged or retaken.

In addition to the academic courses listed above, students are required to fulfill Board requirements, including 10 hours of observation, 40 hours of apprenticeship training, completion of required transcript production, and 10 hours of CSR Prep. Additional details are available on Canvas.
