How Does it Work?

- **Apply before the Feb 27th,2026 deadline**
- **Cohort runs July 2026 - June 2027**, students begin the summer after their Junior Year
- **Students attend Evergreen Beauty College** part time and their regular high school part time
- **Students earn up to 6 high school credits**
 - 3.0 CTE / Elective
 - 1.0 Fine Arts
 - 1.0 ELA
 - 1.0 Lab Science
- **Renton School District covers tuition until graduation**, students will cover approximately 200 of 1600 required hours
- **Renton School District covers 80% of the cost of the student kit**, students keep the kit into their professional careers

What Does the Senior Year Look Like?

- **Periods 1-3 at the high school:** complete any remaining classes required for graduation
 - Social Studies? PE? World Language? Health?
- **1:30 pm - 5:30 pm Monday - Friday: classroom (practical) learning at Evergreen Beauty College's Renton campus**
 - This will continue AFTER high school graduation until they meet the required 1600 hours. While possible to meet all 1600 hours before graduation, most reach 1400 by graduation, completing the remaining in July after graduation.
- **Online coursework, 10 hours per week:** textbook learning is self-paced at approximately 10 hours per week to keep pace with on-campus learning.

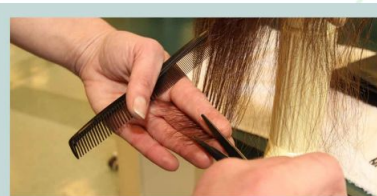

Selection Considerations

Will you be at least 16 by July 1, 2026?

Washington State requires a minimum age of 16 to participate.

On-track to graduate?

Talk to your high school counselor right away to make sure you are taking the classes you need now to leave room in your schedule for this program your senior year!

How is your attendance?

You will be expected to 'adult!' The ideal candidate is self-motivated to meet deadlines and rarely misses days from school. Evergreen Beauty College's attendance policy remove candidates from the program who do not meet attendance requirements.

How are your grades?

This program requires a minimum score of 76% in every unit to continue on in the program.
