# Goal Area #2: Facilities

**Goal Statement:** To enhance and maximize learning opportunities provided by first-class facilities and technological improvements that prepare students for 21st century learning.

***Objectives:***

1. Address facilities issues that impact student achievement by including this in the Five-Year Long-Range Facilities Plan
2. Monitor and hold accountable the cleaning crews tasked with improving appearance and sidewalk appeal of school grounds
3. Provide instructional areas designed/equipped with special built-in equipment for industrial arts and vocational trade learning activities, including but not limited to cosmetology, electrical and plumbing
4. Develop a comprehensive preventative maintenance program that is geared towards the long-term upkeep of all Paterson Public School facilities
5. Prioritize and align with the budget adequate resources for timely implementation



**1. OBJECTIVE:** Address facilities issues that impact student achievement by including this in the Five-Year Long-Range Facilities Plan

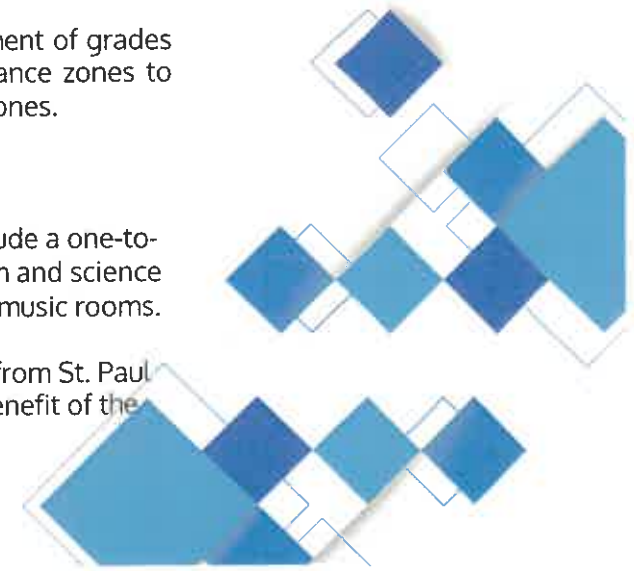
Received NJDOE approval of a major amendment to the Long-Range Facilities Plan.

**LRFP Redistricting Recommendations**

- Develop a New Middle school Model District-wide with new attendance zones and feeder schools
- Use the capacity of the New Middle School to realign grade levels in adjoining attendance zones.
- Enrollment in attendance zones can be modified to balance class sizes relative to the overall size of the school building and keep pre-k and SPED students in within their attendance zones.
- Redistricting, while respecting neighborhood boundaries with few exceptions, will allow for the realignment of grades and an increase in enrollment capacity for special programming, create SPED programming in the attendance zones to reduce transportation costs and will also keep graduating students within the neighborhood attendance zones.

**SATISFIED LRFP GOALS**

- The district opened a new middle school: The Joseph A. Taub Middle School educational features that include a one-to-one environment for teachers and students to each have a personal laptop. There is a project lab, art room and science labs for all grade levels, a regulation size gym, cafetorium with a dance studio on the stage and vocal and music rooms.
- The District also relocated two educational programs, HARP from Colt St. to Paterson Catholic and YMLA from St. Paul to 45 Smith Street, to provide more educationally adequate program spaces for the programs. Another benefit of the relocations is a reduction in the amount of District leased facilities.

**John F Kennedy High School** - Construction Trades Labs, Stock market room, Science Lab Restoration


