

HSE SCHOOLS SUPPORTS FAMILIES EXPERIENCING HOUSING INSTABILITY.

If you are experiencing any of the following situations:

● In a shelter or transitional housing

● In a motel, hotel, or campground because you don't have another safe and stable place to stay

● In a car, park, public place, abandoned building, or bus or train station

● In someone else's house because you lost your housing or are going through a hard time financially and don't have another safe and stable place to stay

Your school-age child(ren) might qualify for help under the federal McKinney-Vento Act.

The McKinney-Vento Act is a federal law that ensures the right of students to go to school even when they are homeless or don't have a permanent address. The Act aims to reduce barriers that have prevented many homeless youths from enrolling, attending, and succeeding in school, including transportation, residency, and documentation requirements, such as birth certificates and medical records.
