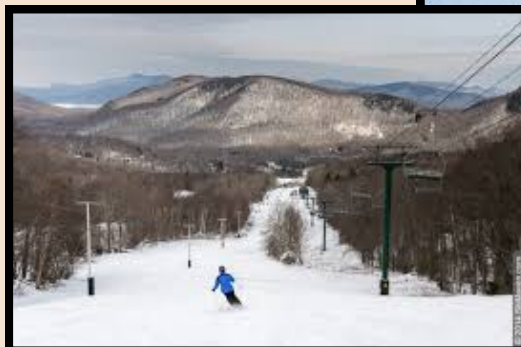

Thanks to our continued participation in a USDA food grant, RPCS also provides fresh fruits and vegetables for snack time three days a week.

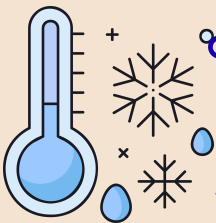


As our winter temperatures drop, we want to ensure all students stay warm, dry, and comfortable during
