WHAT IS THIS CLASS?

This introductory course covers the fundamentals of film and television production, including pre-production, production, and postproduction. Students study film history, camera shots and angles, screenwriting, filming, and editing with industry-standard software like Adobe Premiere Pro, while creating projects such as PSAs, commercials, music videos, news packages, and a short film screenplay. The course also explores studio and location production, film's cultural impact, and prepares students for advanced courses, college, and media careers.

WHO CAN TAKE THIS CLASS?

Film & TV Production I: ANYONE. Just sign-up. No experience necessary.

Film Production II: You must take Film/TV Production I as a prerequisite.

Film Production III: You must take Film II before you can take Film III.

KNOW THIS: This course fulfills a Fine Art, Practical Art, or Elective requirement and offers 3 dual college credits through Los Valley College (LAVC). It provides hands-on experience in filmmaking and video editing while introducing students to career opportunities in the entertainment industry.
