

# TELEVISION PRODUCTION II AND III

## (BROADCAST JOURNALISM) BHS-TV

**WHAT IS THIS CLASS?** TV II and III is a course where students learn how news works: how to find stories, check facts, write scripts, and understand what makes something “newsworthy.” They develop on-camera skills by practicing anchoring, reporting, interviewing, and speaking clearly and confidently. They learn about filming, lighting, sound, and editing using cameras and editing software like Premiere Pro. Teamwork is a huge part of this class where students rotate roles: anchor, reporter, camera operator, editor and producer, so everyone learns different parts of the process. Students create real content by producing our news show **BHS-TV** which is our school's announcements program that gets shown to the school and posted online. It is a great class for students who like storytelling, media, public speaking, or creative tech, and it's especially useful if someone is interested in careers like journalism, broadcasting, film, communications, or content creation.

## WHO CAN TAKE THIS CLASS?

**TV Production II:** ANYONE. Just sign-up. No experience necessary.

**TV Production III:** You must take TV Production II as a prerequisite.

**KNOW THIS:** This course fulfills a Fine Art, Practical Art, or Elective requirement and offers 3 dual college credits through Los Valley College (LAVC). It provides hands-on experience and teaches students how to create news packages, including writing scripts, interviewing, and appearing on camera.
