### About AP<sup>®</sup>

According to College Board, AP courses are challenging and require students to work hard and to be prepared academically. Although “you don’t have to be the top of your class to be an AP student...all AP courses ask that you come willing to do your best work.” Final grades are on a 5-point scale. AP students will sit for the rigorous, formal AP Exam(s) held at Berne Union in May, 2025. Passing scores usually equate to college credit; AP will help students determine when exam scores do equal credit at a chosen college.
