What is College Credit Plus?

College Credit Plus (CCP) is Ohio's dual enrollment program that allows students in grades 7-12 (public, nonpublic or homeschool) to enroll at a college or university to earn both high school and college credits.

Admission Requirements

Visit www.kent.edu/ccp for current eligibility and admission requirements.

Application Deadlines

- » Summer and Fall: **April 15**
- » Spring: **October 15**

Returning CCP students do not need to reapply for admission. Check your Kent State email for registration instructions.

Delivery Options

Courses can be taken on a Kent State campus, at the high school, online or a combination of these options.

Public School Students

Students participating in CCP through a public school district are required to follow the procedures outlined by their district. Contact your guidance office for this information.

Nonpublic and Homeschool Students

Nonpublic and homeschool students must apply to the Ohio Department of Education & Workforce to receive funding for courses for the upcoming academic year. More information is available at higher.ed.ohio.gov/ccp.

Steps to Apply for CCP Admission

1. Meet with your school counselor to discuss your CCP eligibility and opportunities.
 - » Public school students: Complete and submit your school's Letter of Intent form by April 1. *This form is required annually.*
 - » Nonpublic and homeschool students: Submit your funding application and Letter of Intent form to the State by the deadline listed at higher.ed.ohio.gov/ccp.
2. Complete the CCP admission application online at www.kent.edu/ccp.
 - » Create an account.
 - » Complete the application using your full legal name, a personal (non-school) email address, date of birth and social security number.
 - » Indicate your campus location of choice: Kent Campus in Kent or one of our eight Regional Campus locations.
3. Request an official middle school report card or high school transcript from your guidance office and have it sent to transcripts@kent.edu.
4. Complete the CCP Permission Form found in the application portal.

- Notify Kent State if you move or change schools or school districts.
- If applicable to you, nonpublic and homeschool students must upload a copy of your funding letter from the Ohio Department of Education & Workforce to your Kent State applicant portal, or email it to ccp@kent.edu.

Returning CCP students are assigned a registration open date by the institution. Check your Kent State email for instructions on how to register.
