NNAT3 (Naglieri Nonverbal Ability Test) Testing for Gr. 5 Students

Our 5th grade students will be taking the NNAT3 on **Feb. 5** instead of the CogAT this year. Both of these assessments are used as additional data points to identify our students for gifted services. The NNAT3 is a brief 30 minute , computerized, nonverbal assessment measuring general reasoning and problem-solving abilities.

DARE

We're excited to share that our 5th grade students will be participating in the D.A.R.E. (Drug Abuse Resistance Education) program from January 27 through April 7. D.A.R.E. is a police officer–led program designed to help students build the skills they need to make safe, responsible choices. Through age-appropriate lessons, students will learn how to recognize and resist peer pressure related to “gateway” substances such as alcohol, tobacco, marijuana, and inhalants, while also developing self-esteem and strategies for managing emotions. Deputy Beers, an officer with the Summit Co. Sheriff's Dept. and a Bath School parent, will lead the lessons, helping students form positive relationships with police and practice the D.A.R.E. Decision-Making Model—defining problems, assessing choices, responding thoughtfully, and evaluating outcomes. We look forward to this meaningful learning experience for our students.

PTA Read-A-Thon

Our kids will be very excited about upcoming 2026 PTA Read-A-Thon. The love the class competition and will be excited to see homeroom brackets go up in the cafeteria. The competition will begin with a kickoff assembly on March 2 and end on Mar. 15.
