



What is the Seniors to Sophomores Program?

Seniors to sophomores (S2S) is a highly selective, dual enrollment program for seniors that enables them to earn high school and college credit simultaneously. The program will allow students to be challenged academically, gain valuable life skills, and potentially enter college as a sophomore. Student participants are chosen through a selection process after applying and meeting the program's eligibility requirements.

Assistance and Support

The S2S program is part of the State of Ohio's College Credit Plus program. We offer students an additional layer of targeted support and the benefit of collaboration with other CCS students. Participants are selected by the program committee in separate application and acceptance processes.

S2S assistance covers:

- The cost of tuition, books, and fees (*fees like parking and campus recreation center are not covered*)
- Extended COTA bus pass to help with transportation (*district permitting*)

Benefits & Eligibility

Student benefits include exposure to college coursework, a year of college credit (a minimum of 22 semester hours) at no cost, and simultaneous high school and college credit. The courses are weighted on a 5.0 scale, and enrollment in the program comes with academic advising, ongoing check-ins, and collaboration with other CCS students in a cohort.

Eligible Students are:

- Rising Seniors (*students completing 11th grade*)
- Earned a cumulative GPA or 3.0 or higher
- Completed Math III or higher with a B or better
- Completed 3 years of English with a B or better
- On track to meet one state graduation option
- Meets University admission requirements
- College placement exams or ACT/SAT scores may be used to determine student eligibility

Student Application:

The application window, from February to March each year, includes a student's transcript, attendance and discipline records, an essay, a letter of intent, a district information form, an application form, and two letters of recommendation. *Get started here!*
