

**Background Detail for the CHARLES E. BULL Memorial
\$2,500 Scholarship (Giles County or Richland High School)**



Pulaski Lions Club

1. Students who resided in the below described limited geographical area at the time the student was eligible to attend ELKTON ELEMENTARY SCHOOL from the beginning of their seventh grade year continuing through the end of school of their eighth grade year of school and is planning to attend a two or four year accredited college or university in the coming year.
2. The qualified student must have resided in a dwelling that the delivery of United States mail is or would have been delivered to that student's residence along Prospect Road west of US 31 to Cutoff Road to State Route 166 and south along State Route 166 to the Tennessee / Alabama state line; or the qualified student must have resided in a dwelling that the delivery of United States mail is or would have been delivered to that student's residence along Tarpley Shop Road east of US 31 to Lloyd Road and south to the Tennessee/ Alabama State line.
3. Qualified students ***must provide documentation of the aforementioned residential requirements*** with proof of applying to a two or four year accredited college or university to the Guidance Office if the student wishes to be a candidate for this scholarship.
4. The completed application must be received by Friday, March 27, 2026 at the Guidance Office to be turned over to the Pulaski Lions Club.
5. All qualified students' applications will be reviewed by the scholarship committee of the Pulaski Lions Club. The committee will be made up of not less than four and not more than six members of the Pulaski Lions Club, all in good standing.
6. All scholarships payments will be made to the student at an Awards Banquet scheduled by the Pulaski Lions Club.
