- A. Call to Order
 Board Chair Ivette Pantoja called the meeting to order at 5:17 PM

- B. Legislative Priorities Discussion
 District Communications Officer Beth Graser discussed the upcoming Legislative Short Session, the recent Washington County Legislative Summit, Superintendent Travis Reiman discussed the Legislative Priorities handout, and Board members discussed Legislative Priorities.

- C. Bond Development Update
