### FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Who is being surveyed?

- The Georgia Department of Education (GaDOE) is surveying parents of students with disabilities throughout the state of Georgia.

Why is my school asking me to fill out this survey?

- When families and schools work together, students are better prepared for lifelong success. To improve outcomes for students with disabilities, the Georgia Department of Education asks parents to share their perspectives so local schools can build stronger partnerships with families.

What if I don't have access to a computer to take the survey?

- Families may answer the survey by phone through the Special Education Help Desk at 404-657-9968.

What if I have more than one child receiving services? Do I fill out more than one survey?

- Yes. You will fill out one survey for each child with an IEP. When completing multiple surveys, base your responses on each of your children receiving services.

Does my child's teacher see the survey answers?

- No. Your answers are anonymous. Surveys are assigned a coded number, no names.

What happens with the information collected?

- The Georgia Parent Satisfaction Survey allows parents to share their views on how well their local school partners and communicates with families.
