<p><b>Rising PreK and K</b> (20 spaces)</p>	<p><b>Artful Inventions</b></p> <p>In this camp, we will let our creative genius flow. Campers will create their own artful masterpieces. Some of the art projects will include finger painting, bubble painting, tie-dyeing, and rock and leaf painting. We will use puff paint to make some wonderful creations.
