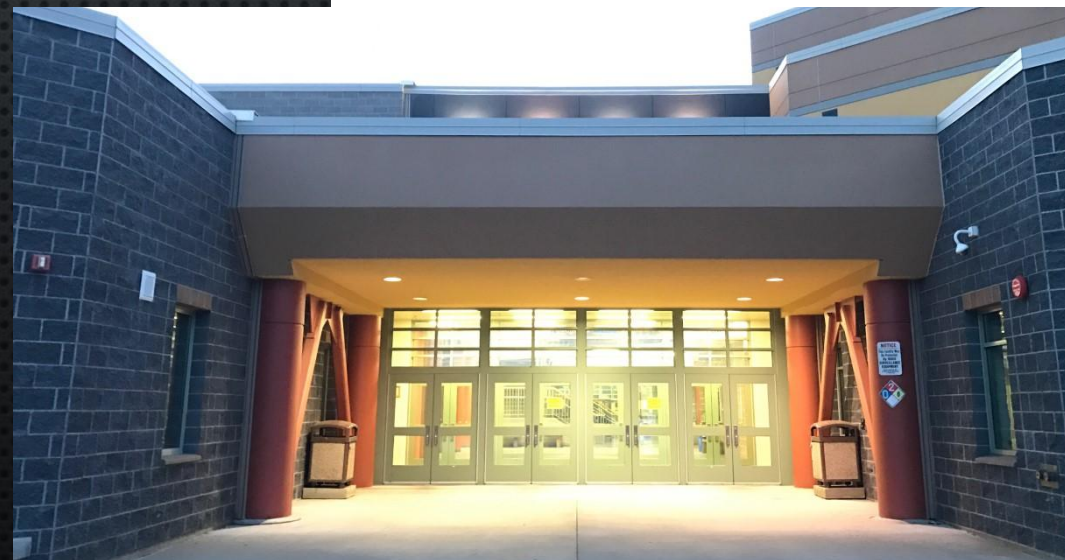

1. Log into **Student Connect**.
2. Select the **Eagle River 2026-2027** track.
3. Select the “**Requests**” tab on the left.
4. Click “**Add/Edit Requests**” on the top right.

Note: Courses are prioritized in the order you add them.

6. Continue adding courses until you have selected **all required core classes** and your **top three elective choices**. An alternate choice is required for each elective.
