Subject	Credits Required
Language Arts	4 credits (8 semesters)
Social Studies	4 credits (8 semesters)
Mathematics	3 credits (6 semesters)
Sciences	3 credits (6 semesters)
PE/Health	1 ½ credits (3 semesters)
Electives	7 credits (14 semesters)
<b>Total</b>	<b>22 ½ credits</b>

# ALASKA PERFORMANCE SCHOLARSHIP

- Up to \$28,000!
- Great Plan A or B
- Available for 8 years after graduation
- No competition - you only need to complete eligibility requirements and the FAFSA to earn the scholarship
- Qualify by completing required classes and earning a high enough GPA or test score
- Can be used at universities and many technical and training programs in Alaska ([see list here!](#))

# SCHEDULING TIPS

Contact your counselor if you have any questions and/or concerns regarding meeting your ASD graduation requirements.

If you have questions regarding college admission requirements, please contact the college/university directly.

Remember, as a senior, you must be enrolled in at least four classes per semester, for sports eligibility.

When selecting your classes, consider your plans after high school and scholarship requirements. Be mindful of other commitments. Be careful not to take on too much. Do as much as you can do well.

- A lot of work goes into creating a master schedule. We anticipate the number of sections based on requests.
- Schedule change requests will be considered based on availability for a brief window prior to each semester start.
- Requests will not be accepted for specific teachers or periods.

# ONLINE COURSE REQUESTS

- STUDENTS WILL HAVE A 2 WEEK WINDOW TO MAKE AND CHANGE COURSE REQUESTS ONLINE:
  - **JUNIORS: JAN 20 – JAN 30**
- SCHEDULE REQUESTS MUST BE MADE BY STUDENTS THROUGH Q/STUDENTCONNECT.
- PARENTS MAY **VIEW** REQUESTS VIA PARENTCONNECTION.

# Online Course Requests - Directions

1. Log in to **Student Connect** between **1/20 - 1/30**.
2. Select the **Eagle River 2026-2027** track.
3. Select the **“Requests”** tab on the left.
4. Click **“Add/Edit Requests”** on the top right.
5. Choose your first course, then click **“Add Selected Class.”**

Note: Courses are prioritized in the order you add them.

6. Continue adding courses until you have selected **all required core classes** and your **top three elective choices**. An alternate choice is required for each elective.
7. Review your selections and click **“Submit”** at the top of the window.

**\*You will only be able to make changes to your requests during the open registration window.**
