

**Section 9-7.4. Admission of non-public students for part-time enrollment prohibited; Exception for homeschool students and JROTC; required conduct for homeschooled students in JROTC** — A. Private and homeschool students shall not be permitted to enroll part-time in Suffolk Public Schools or to participate in academic or extra-curricular activities.

B. Homeschooled students who reside in the school division and who are otherwise eligible for membership in a Junior Reserve Officers' Training Corp (JROTC) unit maintained by a secondary school but for their lack of enrollment in the division is permitted to be members of the unit.

C. Homeschooled students who are members in the school division's JROTC unit are required to conduct themselves in a manner consistent with established standards for student behavior and must comply with behavioral, discipline, attendance and other policies and rules applicable to all students, including rules governing the use of the school division's compute systems. If a student fails to comply, the school may without credit and/or terminate the student's participation in addition to taking any disciplinary action that would be taken against a full-time student for similar conduct.
