# 6<sup>th</sup> Grade Schedule

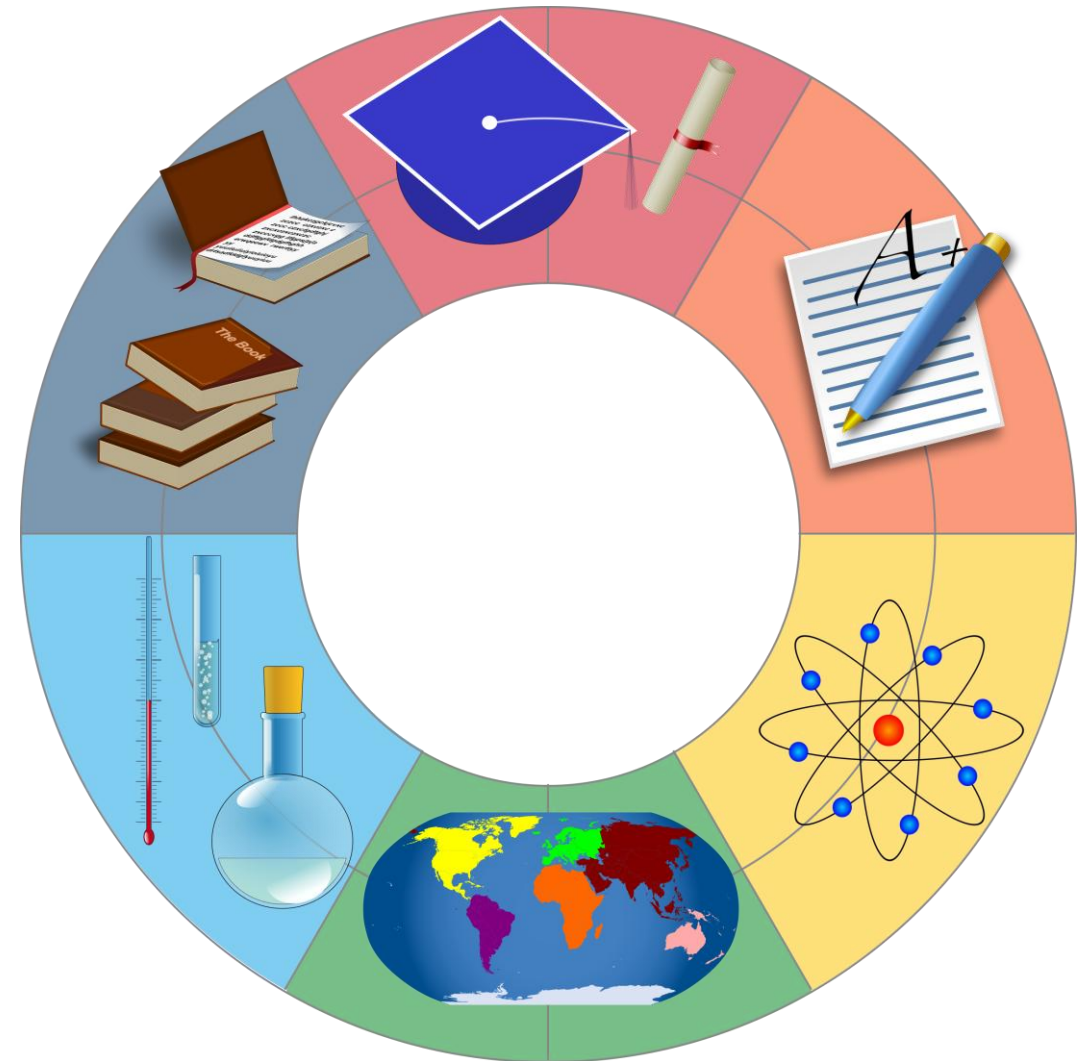
## Required for all students:

## Elective Choices

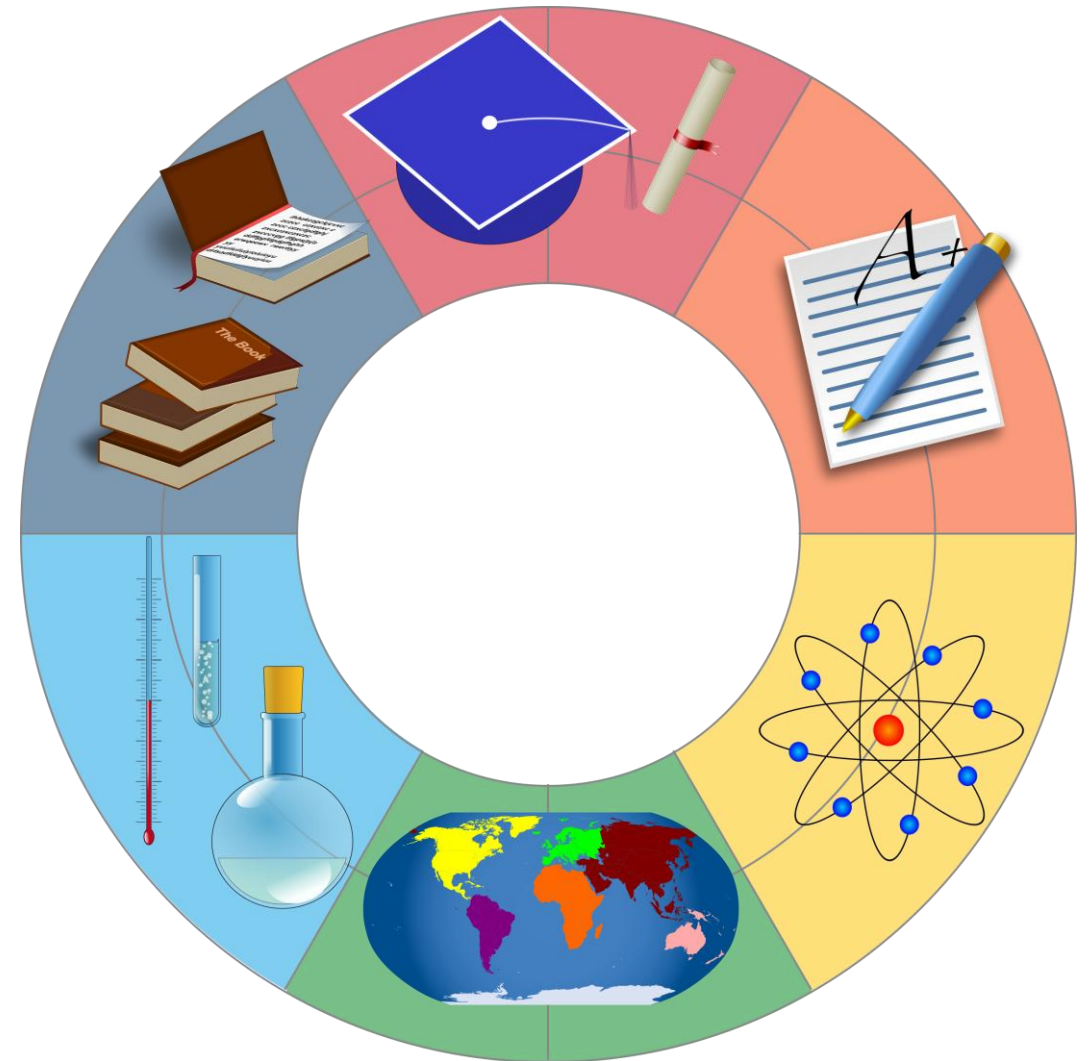
- Music: *Year long*

## Incoming 6<sup>th</sup> Grade Class Selection:

- On Monday, January 26<sup>th</sup>, a presentation was sent out to elementary students and families regarding 6<sup>th</sup> grade elective choices. Your choices are The Elective Wheel OR a year-long music class.
- Families will have until **mid-winter break, February 11<sup>th</sup>**, to submit a Microsoft Form indicating their child's elective choice for 6<sup>th</sup> grade.

# LUNCHES

We run three lunches every day for 30 min each. Students are assigned A, B or C lunch based on their 4<sup>th</sup> period teacher.

# Technology Continued

- Phones and personal electronics
  - Best advice: **leave them at home**
  - Phones, AirPods, etc. are turned off and put away during the day
    - Teachers may allow use during class time
    - They will communicate this to students
  - Personal electronics used without permission are stored in the main office
    - Including when they are used at lunch and in the hallways
