What to Do with the Course Verification Form?

Review the courses on the form. It is just a list of classes (not a schedule).

- Your current teachers have recommended you for the academic courses for next year. These recommendations, with the electives you select, will be used to construct your schedule for next year.
- If making changes, cross out the class and write down the class you want to take instead.
- If changing a class to online through Fulton Virtual, write that down next to that class and complete the Online Contract and submit with the Course Verification Form. Specify AM or PM for when you would prefer the online class.
- If doing Dual enrollment for a class, write that down on the form as well. Complete the Dual Enrollment Process by 3/27/2026. Specify AM or PM.
- Rising Seniors-No Senior Reduction available.
- Add Electives to the Course Verification Form by filling out the boxes at the bottom of the form. List classes in all boxes in order of priority to ensure that you get the classes you would like to take. Please add enough electives to bring your total number of credits to 6.0.
- Submit Completed Course Verification Form and all required documents to BRIDGE WEST by 2/4/2026, 3:30 pm (Wednesday). Failure to submit form will result in your classes being picked for you.

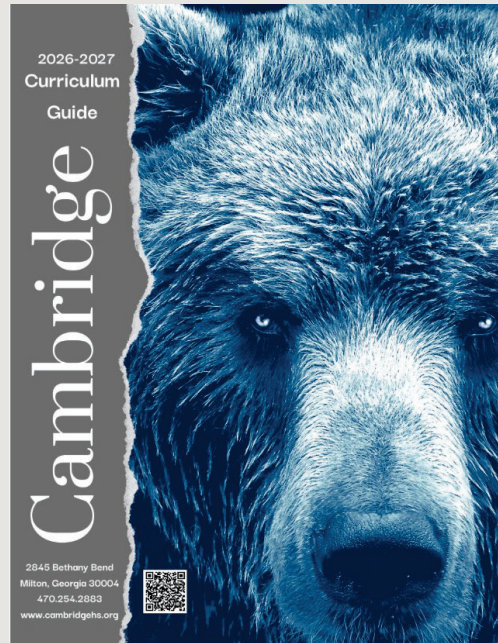

Online Course Regulations

- While students are invited to request morning or afternoon timing for online classes, requested placement cannot be guaranteed. Class placement is determined by the availability of all classes on the student's course request.
- Students taking online classes are not permitted to be on campus during the respective periods. If a student is taking an online class during 1st period, he/she should arrive at school in time for 2nd period. If a student is taking an online class during 6th period, he/she should leave campus at the end of 5th period.
- It is the responsibility of the student and his/her parents or guardians to provide transportation and arrange for timely pick up from and drop off to school. Late arrivals will be marked tardy.
- *Do not make plans (ex., work schedule, extra-curricular schedules, etc.) around course requests. Final schedules are not released until the week prior to the start of the school year.*

Before any online course will be approved, BOTH SIDES OF THIS FORM MUST BE COMPLETED by the student and parent.

I understand that grades for ALL online courses students are enrolled in after the 10th day of the semester will be posted on the student's official Cambridge High School transcript. • All attempted online courses and grades, both passing and failing, will be recorded onto the student's transcript and factored into the overall numeric average.		
I understand that online courses require students to spend at least 1 hour per day on coursework for each 0.5 credit online course.
