Important Bits of Information:

## **Clothing**

A good warm coat, gloves, ski pants, long underwear, warm socks (knee high socks work best in ski boots), and a hat are required.

\*Helmets are not required yet but are highly recommended. We do want to require students to wear a helmet if they are snowboarding. Also, students who are taking the trails through the trees need to be wearing a helmet. Helmets can be picked up at the rental office at the time when students get their equipment.

Additional suggestions: goggles, extra gloves, extra socks, Chapstick, and dry clothes for the ride home.

## **Food**

Please pack enough food for both lunch and dinner. Students will keep their lunches and belongings in their backpack and will be responsible for keeping track of it. While students may buy food at Lookout, it is very expensive. Students will be allowed to eat on the bus on the way home and will be responsible for cleaning up before being dismissed from the bus. If your child brings a beverage, it must have a screw-on lid.

Upon arriving at Lookout, students will be given their skis or snowboards and must attend lessons. New skiers/snowboarders will not be allowed on the lifts until they have had their first lesson. Chaperones are always nearby, but students must ski with a partner or group. Students that ski alone or leave members of their group behind will not be allowed to participate in the next ski trip. **Students are responsible for turning in their equipment** and ready to board the bus at the end of the day. The bus leaves Lookout at 5:00 PM Mountain Standard Time. We will arrive back at the bus loading zone around 6:45 PM. Your promptness will be greatly appreciated as kids and chaperones will be tired and ready to go home.

## **Returning Home**

Weather and road conditions may affect arrival times back at the bus loading zone. By joining the Remind Ski 2026 Group you will receive notice when the bus goes through Plains, MT, giving you advance warning of their arrival time back in Thompson Falls.

## **SKI PROGRAM RULES**

1. All paperwork and money must be turned In by the required dates.
2. All skiers/snowboarders must have all assigned work finished before the trip and have no Fs in any subject area.
3. The bus will leave T-Falls at approximately 8:30 AM and will return to T-Falls at approximately 6:45 PM.
4. **Rides must be arranged before the bus leaves in the morning. Your promptness is very much appreciated,**
5. Lunches need to be in paper and/or plastic sacks. Students are to leave the lodge and buses clean. Please pick up after yourself.
- 6, Please leave all electronics at home. Alternate forms of entertainment might be a **puzzle book, drawing paper, or a book to read. Neither the school nor Lookout are responsible for any lost or stolen items.**
7. All students 4th - 6th grade are required to attend a lesson. Students who miss a lesson will lose their privilege to ski for the remainder of the day and will not be allowed on the next scheduled ski trip.
8. The bus will leave Lookout promptly at 5:00 PM, Mountain Standard Time.
9. **NEVER SKI ALONE** I Let the teachers or chaperones know where you will be skiing. **Students that ski alone will lose their skiing privileges for the remainder of the day and will not be allowed on the next ski trip.**
10. ***Always ski with someone that is at your ability level.*** No taking your friends on a hill they are not ready for.
11. Do not "cry wolf", **Lookout** takes Injuries seriously and an ambulance may be called at your expense.
12. Any inappropriate behavior may Jeopardize the ski program for all! Please be on your best behavior. You are representing yourself and your school!
13. Appropriate behavior Is required on the bus trip as well to continue the program.
14. **You must be in school the day before the ski trip.**
