Wargo Nature Center; \$220 +tax

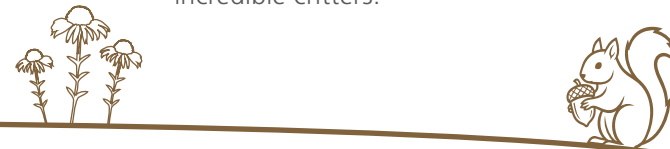

### JUNIOR NATURALIST

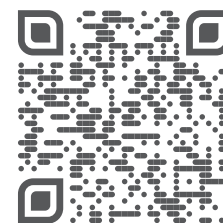
August 17–20; 9 am – 4 pm
