**Richmond County School System will observe a Learn from Home schedule on Monday, Jan. 26**

(AUGUSTA, GEORGIA) – The Richmond County School System (RCSS) continues to monitor current and projected weather conditions and communicate with local emergency management officials. Based on current projections, Richmond County schools will operate on a PowerUp Asynchronous Learning Day schedule on Monday, Jan. 26. Students will complete assignments on their school-issued devices.

After-school activities and athletic events on Saturday, Jan. 24, Sunday, Jan. 25., and Monday, Jan. 26 are canceled.

Teachers will post assignments in Canvas for students and communicate with families through platforms like Remind or Class Dojo. Families that experience a power outage will have additional time to complete assignments upon return to school.

The school system will provide an update on Tuesday, Jan. 27 operations no later than Monday evening.
