Title 1 Information

Creekside is a Title I school. Title I provides federal funding for schools who are behind academically or at risk of falling behind. Funding is based on the number of low-income children in a school, generally those eligible for the free lunch program. About half of the public schools in the state receive Title I funding.

This funding is used to supplement resources, provide remediation teachers and other support staff. Remediation teachers help provide small group instruction for specific skill building in math and reading. This small group instruction is offered at various times in the school day to suit the students class schedule.

Title I hosts parent information sessions to share effective strategies families can use at home to help students learn.

Our teachers meet weekly to plan relevant and rigorous lesson plans; promoting student learning and higher order thinking.
