



## **Jim Miccichi**

Mr. Jim Miccichi began his career at Hopewell-Loudon in 1972. A graduate of Defiance College and Tri-State University, Mr. Miccichi came to Hopewell-Loudon from Edgerton Local Schools, and was the longest serving superintendent in Hopewell-Loudon history. During his eighteen-year tenure as Hopewell-Loudon Superintendent, Jim Miccichi was instrumental in restoring Hopewell-Loudon's reputation and the value of academics, setting into motion the district's ascension to the level of excellence we enjoy today. Under Mr. Miccichi's leadership, the addition of the gymnasium and renovation of the music department was completed in 1988. A former football coach himself, Mr. Miccichi also played an important role in the establishment of the Hopewell-Loudon football program in the early seventies.

Mr. Miccichi had the opportunity to hire many staff members over his 18-year career. Among those persons are many Hopewell-Loudon Hall of Fame members, including 3 being inducted in 2008.
