

## College & Career Promise 11th & 12th Grade only

Career and College Promise (CCP) is a partnership between Cleveland Community College and Kings Mountain High School. Qualified Juniors and Seniors can begin taking college classes tuition free. We have put several courses together to be taught at KMHS during one class period with an instructor from CCC. During registration, students are placed in one course of the sequence (underlined courses). We can only schedule 1 course at a time. When the first course ends students will be placed in the next course. Course order is determined prior to the start of the semester and is not necessarily in the order listed below. Students will receive the full sequence of courses that are listed in the registration guide during the semester they are scheduled. Cleveland Community College requires a minimum of 8 students to be enrolled in a class in order for it to be offered.

**Eligibility requirements** - Students must have an UNWEIGHTED 2.8 GPA to take CCP courses. Students will receive both high school and college credit (must make a C or higher to earn college credit). Students will not be allowed to withdraw/drop from classes once they have registered and are enrolled in these courses.

### 1. College Transfer Courses:

- All courses in this pathway will receive 1 extra quality point towards their GPA.
- These are high level academic courses that will require homework and studying outside of the classroom. You are expected to maintain good attendance because you must follow the attendance policy of the course in order to gain credit.
